This summer Team Effort came to Pender County's Hampstead area to help people in need with home repair projects.

Team Effort is a non-profit youth mission organization that has brought over 95,000 youth & leaders from thousands of different denominations to work side by side and make an impact of service throughout the Country.

Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) Director Barbara Mullins assisted with applications for RSVP clients, seniors at both Senior Centers complete applications and referrals were made by Meals on Wheels volunteers.

Team Effort coordinator Dakota Bishop met with Barbara and canvassed our requests for potential work to be done. Mission groups arrived each week from June through early August and stayed at beautiful Topsail Beach. The donation they made to Pender County was priceless. The end result was absolutely amazing: two new roofs; a complete floor in a trailer

was replaced; worn carpet (safety issue for client) was completely ripped out and replaced with tile flooring; a front room was painted, a shed torn down and new one was built, handrails were on a handicap ramp; three screened in porches were built; a handicap ramp was built, siding was replaced; a concrete slab was added so step would not be so steep.

RSVP volunteers served lunch once a week to the mission groups that donated the supplies, the energy and man-power to get these repairs done. Each group gave willingly and made us believe there are so many great teenagers in this world.
